JOHN & RITA DOWNING'S CAR!

BEFORE & AFTER

John Downing's 1962 Grand Prix did make it home before the snow started to fly. John was happy to pick up his car at T&R Collision – they did a great job – the paint looks terrific. To help speed up the process, John helped to re-assemble the car. He is now working all the finishing touches. John wanted the 62 because it was the first year of the Grand Prix, Pontiac's entry into the luxury/sports market. It has a unique look, specific grille and tail light panel, set lower than other models. Buckets seats, tachometer, 389 cubic inch engine, and 303 HP were all standard. Clean styling, lack of chrome trim and name plates made it instantly identifiable from other models. This was the lowest production Grand Prix manufactured with only 30,195 produced in a year that would see Pontiac sell over 521,000 model cars putting it in third place for vehicle production in the U.S.



GOOD VISION IN A DOWNPOUR

How to achieve good vision while driving during a heavy downpour. We are not sure why it is so effective; just try this method when it rains heavily. This method was told by a Police friend who had experienced and confirmed it. It is useful...even driving at night. Most of the motorists would turn on HIGH or FASTEST SPEED of the wipers during heavy downpour, yet the visibility in front of the windshield is still bad.....

In the event you face such a situation, just try your SUN GLASSES (any model will do), and miracle! All of a sudden, your visibility in front of your windshield is perfectly clear, as if there is no rain. Make sure you always have a pair of SUN GLASSES in your car, as you are not only helping yourself to drive safely with good vision, but also might save your friend's life by giving him this idea.. Try it yourself and share it with your friends! Amazing, you still see the drops on the windshield, but not the sheet of rain falling.

You can see where the rain bounces off the road. It works to eliminate the "blindness" from passing semi's spraying you too.Or the "kick up" if you are following a semi or car in the rain. They ought to teach that little tip in driver's training.. It really does work.

This warning is a good one! I wonder how many people know about this~A 36 year old female had an accident several weeks ago and totaled her car. A resident of Kilgore , Texas she was traveling between Gladewater & Kilgore. It was raining, though not excessively, when her car suddenly began to hydro-plane and literally flew through the air. She was not seriously injured but very stunned at the sudden occurrence!

When she explained to the highway patrolman what had happened he told her something that every driver should know - NEVER DRIVE IN THE RAIN WITH YOUR CRUISE CONTROL ON. She thought she was being cautious by setting the cruise control and maintaining a safe consistent speed in the rain.. But the highway patrolman told her that if the cruise control is on when your car begins to hydro-plane and your tires lose contact with the pavement, your car will accelerate to a higher rate of speed making you take off like an airplane. She told the patrolman that was exactly what had occurred.

The patrolman said this warning should be listed, on the driver's seat sun-visor - NEVER USE THE CRUISE CONTROL WHEN THE PAVEMENT IS WET OR ICY, along with the airbag warning. We tell our teenagers to set the cruise control and drive a safe speed - but we don't tell them to use the cruise control only when the pavement is dry. The only person the accident victim found, who knew this (besides the patrolman), was a man who had a similar accident, totaled his car and sustained severe injuries. NOTE: Some vehicles (like the Toyota Sienna Limited XLE) will not allow you to set the cruise control when the windshield wipers are on. If you CHOOSE to send this to 15 people and only one of them doesn't know about this, then it was all worth it. You might have saved a life.
